# Parkview Academy



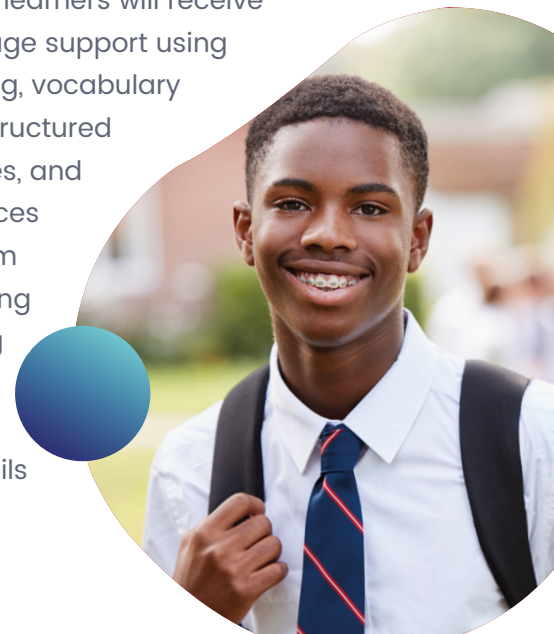

While our curriculum fulfils the formal requirements of the National Curriculum, it also extends far beyond the classroom, ensuring that pupils benefit from meaningful, varied, and enriching opportunities.**

Our approach is strengthened by a commitment to Values-based Education—including British Values, which promotes confident, self-motivated, and respectful learners. We believe that every child should feel valued and experience success across a broad range of curriculum areas. The physical and mental well-being of our pupils is a priority, and our curriculum is thoughtfully designed to balance academic progress with personal growth. Core and foundation subjects are given equal importance to ensure a holistic educational experience.

We understand that children learn best when they feel emotionally secure. For this reason,

our curriculum is therapeutic, holistic, and responsive to individual needs and interests. Our personalised, child-centred approach ensures that every learner can access a broad and balanced curriculum through active, engaging, and meaningful learning experiences. We firmly believe that a student's self-esteem, confidence, and emotional stability can be greatly enhanced through academic achievement and positive personal and social experiences.

Parkview Academy is committed to meeting the needs of pupils who speak English as an Additional Language (EAL). We recognise the cultural and linguistic diversity these learners bring and use these strengths to enrich our school community. EAL learners will receive targeted language support using visual scaffolding, vocabulary development, structured talk opportunities, and adapted resources that enable them to access learning without lowering expectations. Our goal is to support EAL pupils





in developing English proficiency, confidence, and full integration into every aspect of school life.

Our curriculum is designed with a clear intent, robust implementation, and strong focus on impact. We aim to ensure that the curriculum not only meets students' academic and emotional needs but also enables them to build cultural capital so they can succeed in whatever pathways they choose. By offering diverse learning experiences, we empower students to broaden their understanding of the world and develop the knowledge and skills necessary for future success.

Parkview Academy employs highly qualified staff who participate in continuous professional development (CPD). All staff follow a structured induction programme and receive both GCM and PACE training. This commitment to high-quality professional learning ensures that teaching is consistent, evidence-informed, and responsive to pupils' needs.

Interventions are identified from each student's EHCP and planned alongside their personal timetables. This ensures that support is targeted, meaningful, and embedded within each student's daily learning experience.

We maintain small class sizes—no more than six students per group—supported by both a teacher and a Learning Support Assistant (LSA). Learning is facilitated within year groups wherever possible, and progress is implemented sequentially across subjects to support continuity and progression. Parkview Academy is registered for 25 students across Key Stages 3 and 4.
